## Upper Division Course Requirements

The BSN Upper Division Courses are made up of 64 semester credits. Students who are admitted are expected to begin in July. All students are required to follow a set curriculum each semester. Upon successful completion of the curriculum and clinical experiences, students following the Generic Program will graduate 23 months after entry. Students following the Accelerated and RN to BSN Programs will graduate 18 months after entry.
